

Pathway Internship - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. When does the Pathway Internship programme take place?

The Pathway Internship Programme is a 10-week structured programme that takes place during the summer, between May and August. It is targeted at penultimate year students who are keen to be considered for roles in our front office.

2. Who is eligible to apply for the Pathway Internship?

The programme is open to all undergraduates in their penultimate year of studies with demonstrated interest in finance.

3. Are part-time Internships offered for Pathway Internship?

Interns must commit full-time for the entire duration of 10 weeks.

4. What is the application process?

Applicants should submit a cover letter (under 300 words) outlining their preferred business area (Client Coverage Group, Markets & Investor Services or Clifford Capital Asset Management) and their motivation for joining Clifford Capital.

Shortlisted applicants will undergo initial interviews and case study assessments. Selected applicants will then be invited to final interviews.

5. Does the Pathway Internship Programme lead to a full-time job offer?

All Pathway Interns will be assessed for their potential and may receive full-time opportunities with us upon graduation.

6. Can I apply to more than one business area?
